



## STRIKE PREPAREDNESS COMMITTEE: CALL FOR MEMBERS

### What is the Strike Preparedness Committee (SPC)?

- The Strike Preparedness Committee (SPC) is responsible for the overall coordination of planning and implementation of strike action, if collective bargaining with Western reaches an impasse and if the UWOSA membership votes to move forward with strike action. The SPC is sub-divided into working groups, based on interest.

### What are the Working Groups?

- Communications
- Finance
- Picket Lines
- Strike Headquarters



### What are some of the responsibilities?

- Securing and set-up of strike headquarters
- Coordinating picket line duties (may include picketer scheduling, food/beverage distribution), strike captain duties
- Member bulletins, picket line bulletins, call to action material distribution
- Weekly strike pay generation, invoice payment for strike action expenses, financial letters of assistance generation, etc.
