What is the Strike Preparedness Committee (SPC)?

 The Strike Preparedness Committee (SPC) involves union members outside of the negotiations team and stewards council. The committee's primary responsibility is to plan, implement and coordinate strike action, if our negotiations team reaches an impasse with Western and our membership votes to go on strike. Our committee is sub-divided into four working groups.

What are the Working Groups?

- Communications
- Finance
- Picket Lines
- Strike Headquarters

What are some of the responsibilities?

- Securing and set-up of strike headquarters
- Coordinating picket line duties (may include picketer scheduling, food/beverage distribution), strike captain duties
- Member bulletins, picket line bulletins, call to action material distribution
- Weekly strike pay generation, invoice payment for strike action expenses, financial letters of assistance generation, etc.
