#### **NEW in 2024: Caregiver Days**

Beginning in 2024, UWOSA Members will be granted up to <u>three paid days</u> per calendar year to care for their family and loved ones during critical times.

**KEY POINTS:** The three Caregiving Days shall not accumulate or carry over to a new calendar year. If only a partial day is needed, it will still be counted as a full day in terms of paid entitlement.



Health Care Spending Account (HCSA) Allocation Amounts Increase Effective January 1, 2024

Starting January 1, 2024, each eligible Continuing and Sessional UWOSA member will receive an increased 2024 HCSA allocation. The allocation for eligible members with family coverage will be \$1,020, and the allocation for single coverage is \$795. To learn more about your HCSA click **HERE**.
