What's been happening in your area?


We have been quite busy throughout the pandemic, and currently have multiple new buildings on the go to complete. Dallas Heywood Steward Faculty of Education

How does Progression Through the Ranks (PTR) work?

Progression Through the Ranks (PTR) is explained in Article 45 "Wages and Benefits" of the <u>UWOSA Collective Agreement</u>. Generally a new employee starts at the lowest pay grade in their band ("Min."), but they may be placed higher on the wage grid based on the candidate's skills and experience (Art. 45.03)

On July 1 of each year, all non-probationary Continuing and Sessional UWOSA members below the normal maximum of their range will move to the next step up in the range, and we all move to the next salary grid. For example, a Continuing or Sessional member hired into a Level M job at the minimum would move from \$24.92/hr (Min Level M on Appendix W) to \$26.06/hr (Step 1 Level M on Appendix X) on July 1, 2022.

Please note that term members are not eligible to receive the progression through the ranks (PTR) increases, but will move from Appendix W to Appendix X on July 1, 2022, which is a 1% raise.
